Vice Gov. Oyo Uy distributes relief supplies in flood-stricken areas

Vice Governor De Carlo "Oyo" Uy leads the distribution of relief supplies to families affected by flash floods in the Municipalities of Carmen and Asuncion, Davao del Norte. The young vice governor personally visited the evacuees at the Municipal Gym of Carmen together with Carmen Mayor Leonidas Bahague on February 23 and at the affected families of the Municipality of Asuncion with Mayor Eufrazio Dayaday on February 24, 2023.

Around 1,800 evacuees affected by flash floods due to heavy rains were given free breakfast. On the very same day, Vice Governor Oyo Uy joined

Tagum City Mayor Rey T. Uy, who turned over 1.2 million pesos as financial help from the Local Government Unit of Tagum to the flood victims. Tagum City Councilor Joedel Caasi and Board Member Emmanuel Pamisaran were also present during the turnover.

In the morning of February 24, amidst the holiday (in commemoration of the EDSA People Power Revolution's 37th anniversary, in lieu of Feb. 25, which falls on a Saturday), around 750 relief supplies were distributed to those affected by the flood in the municipality of Asuncion with Mayor Dayaday. The said kinds and goods were given courtesy of the Department

of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD), Office of House Speaker Ferdinand Martin Romualdez, and Tingog Partylist.

On February 27, Vice Governor Oyo Uy visited again several areas in Carmen to distribute relief goods to those affected by the flood. This time, he was joined by Special Assistant to the President (SAP) Anton Lagdameo, DSWD Secretary Rex Gatchalian, and Congressman Alan "Aldu" Dujali.

Vice Governor Oyo Uy further assured that aid shall be provided to the people of Davao del Norte, especially those who highly need it in times of calamities.





BM Aala leads SP's approval of Resolution No. 247 declaring DavNor under State of Calamity

Known as proficient and service-oriented veteran legislator of this province for many years, serving as Sangguniang Panlalawigan Member for over a decade, 1st District Board Member Shirley Belen R. Aala again has shown her prowess by leading the SP in crafting legislative measures beneficial to the constituents of Davao del Norte. When the Honorable Governor Edwin I. Jubahib sent a letter to the Sangguniang Panlalawigan last January 30, 2023 recommending for a passage of resolution to declare the province under a state of calamity due to the presence of frequent heavy rains, BM Aala, as Chairperson of the Committee on Peace and Order and Public Safety, urgently acted on the Governor's request by convening its committee members for the said measure.

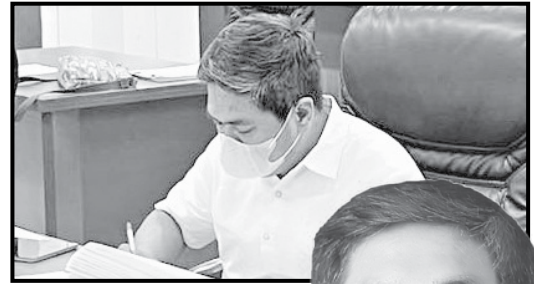
After minutes of discussions, the committee composed of Bm Aala as chair and its members such as Senior Board Member Flopone

A. Catalan, Board Members Robert L. So, Emerson Dave A. Silotan, LPT, and Nicandro T. Suaybaguio, Jr., UAP decided to pass Resolution No. 247 and recommended it for approval. Consequently, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on its 7th Regular Session held last February 7, 2023 approved the said measure for its third and final reading.

Subsequently, the Local Government of Davao del Norte has released the funds for the victims of the said frequent rains. About Twenty-Five Million Seven Hundred Twenty-Two Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Six Pesos and Seventeen Centavos (P25,722,456.17) calamity fund was distributed to Thirty-Six (36) Barangays consisting of Five Hundred Eighty-Six (586) families reaching Eighty-five Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety-Eight (85,898) individuals. The calamity fund distribution was based on the data presented in the Report of the

Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) conducted by the Provincial Disaster Risks Reduction and Management Council (PDRRMC) and Provincial Social Welfare and Development Office on January 12, 2023.

The Declaration of the province under a state of calamity through Resolution No. 247, series of 2023 authored by BM Aala, adheres to the NDRRMC Memorandum No. 60, s-2019, which states that "when two or more municipalities or cities are affected by a disaster, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, upon the recommendation of the Provincial DRRM Council, may declare the entire province under a State of Calamity," and it further states that "the declaration and lifting of the state of calamity may also be issued by the Local Sanggunian, upon the recommendation of the LDRRMC, based on the results of the damage assessment and needs analysis."



A legacy worth continuing...

Board Member Nicandro "Nickel" Tumbocon Suaybaguio Jr. was born on the 3rd day of December in the year 1979. He is the 3rd among the five children of Retired BIR District Officer Nicandro Rina Suaybaguio Sr. and retired public school teacher Mrs. Elnora Tumbocon Suaybaguio. He's bloodline is a combination of Bohol-Leyte-Aklan. Nickel was married to Miracel Salvana Buot and blessed with a daughter, Ma. Nicaella and two sons, Mikael and Joaquin.

In his early days, he spent his elementary education at Magugpo Pilot Imelda Elementary School in which he excelled in academics and arts. It was natural and innate in him the leadership and charisma since he became the president of the student government council. He got his first taste of independence upon entering secondary school at the Ateneo de Davao High School in Davao City. There, Nickel spent his teenage years learning the principals and teachings of a Catholic School run by Jesuit Priests. He learned and embraced the Ignatian Values, "To be Men and Women for Others." After high school graduation, he decided to follow his older brother in Manila and enrolled at the Mapua Institute of Technology, the country's premier school known in the field of Engineering and Architecture. He graduated and earned his degree in Bachelor of Science in Architecture and spent more years in the capital for his apprenticeship.

But fate took its turn when Politics and Public Service inevitably redirected his course from being an Architect to being a Public Servant. In the year 2007, at the age of 27 years old, he was elected as a City Councilor of Tagum. Truly fate and destiny led him to serve the community just like his forefathers that marked their family to be pioneer leaders of Tagum and the

province of Davao del Norte. Nickel is the grandson of the late Manuel "Maning" Baura Suaybaguio who became the First Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Tagum in 1930's, the nephew of the late Arnaldo "Noli" Rina Suaybaguio, once a municipal vice-mayor of then Municipality of Tagum, the nephew of the First City Mayor of Tagum and former Vice Governor of Davao del Norte, Victorio "Baby" Rina Suaybaguio, and many others who dedicated and joined public service. Nickel served for nine (9) consecutive years (3 terms) in the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Tagum City from 2007 up to 2016. He crafted and passed many landmark legislations that greatly contributed to the development and welfare of the City of Tagum. To mention a few, he was known to be the "Father of Local Housing Code" when he authored the said ordinance that paved the way for the creation of Housing Department of the Local Government of Tagum. Urban Poor sectors was given due recognition, housing development was given utmost importance being evident to the establishment of more relocation/resettlement areas, urban planning and strict regulation and implementation of private housing developers. Being a son of a public-school teacher, Nickel crafted the "Daycare Teachers Code of Tagum City" and for all public-school teachers in Tagum City, he founded the "Basic Education Assistance Program". He was known to be a young, dynamic legislator and a charismatic politician. Nickel always looked up to the legacy of his family in the service for the community.

After having been elected for full three terms as councilor, Nickel took a rest for a while in public office and decided to pursue his long overdue passion in the field of construction and architecture. He

became a Professional Licensed Architect and established a career in private sector. Not for long, public service once again knocked on his door. This time, an offer not only to serve within the four corners of the City of Tagum

but the entire Province of Davao del Norte. Being one of the youngest politicians and a known dynamic-charismatic leader in the province of Davao del Norte, opportunity was given to him as he was elected as Board Member. During his first term, he holds the chairmanship of the Committee on Education and Culture and passed the Provincial wide adoption of one of his landmark legislation since he was a councilor, "The Daycare Teachers Code of the Province of Davao del Norte". He also passes a legislation which answers the call of our brothers and sisters in the vulnerable sector of PWD which gives them a priority seat at the Local Government Unit of the Province.

He is now in his second term holding the Committee on Tourism and the Committee on Sisterhood Ties and International Relations, and opted to craft more legislative measures that will surely benefit the community. Undoubtedly, this young man has still a long way to go to make his mark as a genuine public servant that will give his contributions to bring the Province of Davao del Norte to greater heights. 🇵🇭

BM Dra. Lu supports Kapalong's cancer mitigation ordinance

As a physician and Chairperson of the Committee on Health of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, 2nd District Board Member Hon. Denise Marianne A. Lu, MD is strongly supportive to any health advocacy campaign of the Cities and Municipalities of Davao del Norte. Upon receipt of the referred measure coming from the Municipality of Kapalong, she immediately convened the Committee on Health she chaired to review and discuss together Municipal Ordinance No. 1264, Series of 2023 of the said municipality, and came up with a legislative measure that strongly supports the municipality's cancer awareness and mitigation mechanism by crafting SP Resolution No. 268.

The subject Municipal Ordinance of Kapalong was created pursuant to R.A. 11215 otherwise known as the "National Integrated Cancer Control Act" that expressly states that the Department of Health (DOH), Local Government Units (LGUs) and other

Government Agencies (GAs) concerned shall strengthen the capability of public health systems and facilities, provisions of services and continuum care. The purpose therefore of the said Municipal Ordinance is to promote cancer awareness in the Municipality, provide plans and programs that would mitigate its affliction, and afford patient care and cure mechanism to overcome this illness.

BM Lu's committee thoroughly discussed and deliberated the merits of the said Municipal Ordinance and recommended to approve the same for being in order and within the bounds of law. She finally passed Resolution No. 268, Series of 2023, entitled: "Approving Municipal Ordinance No. 1264, Series of 2023 of the Sangguniang Bayan



of Kapalong, this province, "an ordinance instituting cancer awareness, creating a municipal council which will be tasked to formulate mechanisms and plans for the prevention and treatment thereof and for other purposes in the Municipality of Kapalong." It has been approved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan during its 8th Regular Session last February 20, 2023.

BM Lu recommends the same ordinance to be crafted in other cities and municipalities of the province in order to protect and promote the right to health of the people, instill health consciousness and cancer awareness campaign in the entire province. 🇵🇭

Dennis Dean T. Castillo, MPA.

As head of the Committee on Finance, Budget and Appropriation, BM Orly enacted notable legislations for the said period in support to the plans and programs of the Provincial Government headed by Honorable Governor Edwin "Kuya Gob" Jubahib, to include the following: the Approved Budget of the Province of Davao del Norte for CY 2023 (A.O. # 2022-005); Financial Assistance Extended by the Provincial Government to its Barangay Functionaries, such as Accredited Barangay Volunteer Barangay Sanitary Inspectors (BSI), Accredited Barangay Health Workers (BHWs), and Accredited Schisto Control Workers (SCWs) (P.O. # 2022-014, 2022-015, and 2022-016); Financial Assistance amounting to Five Thousand

Pesos (Php5,000.00) per annum to Rapid Diagnostic Test Volunteers (P.O # 2022-017); Financial Assistance to every barangay of the province amounting to Fifty Thousand Pesos (Php50,000.00) from the original amount of Php 25,000.00 for its celebration of Araw ng Barangay (P.O. # 2022-020); and the grant of additional incentives to all the employees of the Provincial Government in the amount of Thirty-Nine Million Pesos (Php39,000,000.00) (A.O # 2022-007)

On top of authoring/sponsoring the greatest number of resolutions and ordinances, BM Orly Amit gathered high percentage attendance in legislative session for the period of six months since he took his oath of office as member of the provincial sanggunian. 🇵🇭
